

1. The Journey of the Soul

Discover the classic stages of the spiritual life: purgation, illumination, and union. Learn how God lovingly leads us from struggle to abiding joy.

2. Ignatian Spirituality - Prayerful Awareness

Enter the rich tradition of St. Ignatius of Loyola, learning to notice God in all things through simple, life-giving practices like the Examen and imaginative prayer.

3. Benedictine Spirituality - Finding God in Rhythm

Rediscover the gift of order and balance through Benedictine prayer, *lectio divina*, and the sanctification of ordinary life.

4. Franciscan Spirituality - Joyful Simplicity & Service

Let St. Francis of Assisi teach you the freedom of poverty, the joy of serving the poor, and the beauty of creation as a song of praise.

Each Session Includes:

- Short, accessible teaching
- Guided prayer experiences
- Time for reflection and sharing
- Practical tools to take into your daily life
