Under the terms of the Data Protection Act the information declared on this form will be stored and used only by the PCC of St Mary's Stanwell and St Matthew's Ashford for internal use. This information will not be passed on to any third party.

- 1. These details are not required to be filled in to be included on the Electoral Roll. They are placed on this form, so that the parish may use the information to keep in touch with you more effectively and to provide information to the diocese of age profiles of parishes.
- 2. If your 16th birthday falls in the next 12 months, you may complete the form and become eligible to be entered on the Roll on your birthday.
- 3. The only Churches at present in communion with the Church of England are other Anglican Churches and certain foreign Churches.
- 4. Every six years a new roll is prepared and those on the previous roll are informed so that they can re-apply. If you are not resident in the parish but were on the roll as an habitual worshipper and have been prevented by sickness or absence or other essential reason from worshiping for the past six months, you may write "would" before "have habitually attended" on the form and add "but was prevented from doing so because..." and then state the reason.
- 5. Membership of the Electoral Roll is open to members in good standing of a Church not in communion with the Church of England which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity where those members are also prepared to declare themselves to be members of the Church of England.
- 6. In this form "parish" means ecclesiastical parish

Your privacy is important to us, and we want to communicate with church members in a way which has their consent, and which is in line with UK law on data protection.
